# Tdap vaccine

## Students entering 6-12 grades

- State requirement for students entering 6-12 grades
- Tdap vaccine to help guard students against the rise in Pertussis (whooping cough)



- Any child entering sixth (6<sup>th</sup>) grade shall show proof of receiving one dose of Tdap vaccine regardless of the interval since the last Dtap, DT or Td dose.
- Students entering grades seventh-twelfth (7<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup>) grades who have not already received Tdap are required to receive one Tdap dose regardless of the interval since the last Dtap, DT or Td dose.



# Mandated 6<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> grade physicals

- Students entering sixth (6<sup>th</sup>) and ninth (9<sup>th</sup>) grade for the 2012-2013 school year will need to have a complete school physical, including all updated immunizations and a one dose of the Tdap vaccine.
- This school physical is mandated by the State of Illinois and should be completed prior to the 1st day of school attendance for the 2012-2013 school year.
