The meeting convened at 7:05 a.m.

Bob Tibbs gave an update on the middle school building projects that are currently underway. He is painting the building, asbestos abatement, replacing ceiling tiles, finishing part of the roof (\$15K) and stated that the renovations would be the same regardless of Kindergarten or 5th grade center.

Technology department stated that the costs should be the same regardless of what direction the Board decides for the MS building.

Dave Root reviewed an extensive list of issues for the Board to consider related to:

Growth projections, lunch service, costs, special education, technology, specials (Art, Music, PE, Library), RTI coverage, Head teacher, administration evaluations, building aides, secretary, custodian, facility needs, teacher travel, transportation, parking, storage, mentoring, recess, common planning time, counselor, nurse, speech, OTPT, teacher supplies and needs, start and end times, before care and after care, and possible high school growth.

Mr. Root stated pros and cons associated to both arrangements. In addition, he reiterated the importance of the long term plan, possible expansion in the future, the social importance of sequential grade level proximity, and to consider the cumulative costs in their decision – one way or another.

The Board and Mr. Root agreed that we would like to continue to examine specific components of the move and scheduled another meeting on Thursday, Nov. 1st at 7:00 AM in the district office.
