- **Sherman PTO** has supplied over \$128,000 in SES school supplies, playground equipment, and classroom technology over the past 3 years. This investment in education has allowed the SES staff to enhance the learning opportunities for our students.
- **Vocal Music Boosters** has supplied over \$13,000 in vocal music and drama supplies over the past 3 years. This support has enabled the vocal music program to grow and flourish.
- **Band Boosters** has supplied over \$49,500 in 6-12 band supplies, equipment, and trip funding. Their financial support has provided additional options and music opportunities for our students.
- **Social Media** is the platform that lets us all showcase learning, market our schools, and tell our story. If we don't tell our story no one will. #bulletpride
