2. The BeeBee girls track team had a busy and productive break. They started the week with a meet against Tri-City and Greenview. Some of the highlights from the seventh grade included first place finishes by Grace Gudwien (1600m and 800m); Zoe Horton and Lizzie Bleyer tying in the long jump (10'10"); and the 4x200 relay team of Lizzie Bleyer; Erica Vinger; Kaylin Mumaw; and Gabi Huston; and the 4x100 relay team of Mary Rose Henderson; Athena Welander; Aubreyanna Brown and Haylee Kirkman. The eighth grade team also picked up quite a few firsts – Becca Coughlin in the hurdles and 400m; Caroline McCormick in the 100m; and Bridget Rhodes in the 200m and high jump, and Peyton Bangert in the long jump. All three 8<sup>th</sup> grade relay teams took first place as well – 4X100 – Caroline McCormick, Anni Penk, Rylee Manka, and Tessa Musselman; 4x200 – Allie Karras; Leah Musselman; Bridget Rhodes, and Peyton Bangert; and the 4x400 – Allie Karras, Leah Musselman, Sarah Richardson, and Bridget Rhodes.
