Dear 8th Grade Students and Parents:

This is just a reminder of upcoming events for 8th graders.

On Friday, May 24, we will hold our Annual Awards Assembly beginning at 10:00 a.m. in the gym for 8th graders. Parents are invited to attend. Eighth grade students will be treated to a picnic lunch followed by graduation practice and will then gather to receive their yearbooks. This will be a full day of school for the 8th graders with dismissal at 3:12 p.m. Personal appointments, such as hair and nail appointments will not be an excused absence from school.

Graduation is scheduled for 7:00 p.m. on Friday, May 24. Students should arrive at the Junior High School by 6:45 p.m., meeting in the Fine Arts Gym. Girls need to wear dresses and boys in dress pants, shirt and tie. Clothing must follow the WJHS dress code. Students may not wear or carry flowers. Please no tennis shoes.

Anyone entering the gym must have a ticket.

Students will receive their report cards on May 24, at their graduation and their graduation certificates upon returning from Six Flags on May 28.

Eighth graders who qualified will be going to Six Flags on Tuesday, May 28. Students should be at school by 7:15.
