The 7th grade boys won the meet last night with 96 points. Second was Beardstown with 61. Highlights were Riley Jones was second in the hurdles, Evan Horn won the 1600 meter run, the 4x100 team finished first, Drew Moffett won the 200 meter dash, the 4x400 meter relay team won, Brad Olysav won the shot put and the discus, Brendon Bishop won the long jump and Cameron Southard won the pole vault with a new personal record of 9'3".

8th grade boys won the meet with 73 points. Second was Riverton with 60 points.
