End of the Year Dates to Remember:

Friday, May 23: This is the last day of attendance for 8th graders. Their awards assembly will take place in the Athletics Gym at 10:00 a.m. with graduation practice to follow their awards assembly. There will be an eighth grade pizza party to follow practice with special activities in the afternoon. Students who ordered yearbooks will get them at the end of the day. We will also have extras for sale for \$25.00. This is a full day for 8th graders and students must be in attendance the whole day in order to participate in their graduation ceremony. The ceremony takes place at 6:30 p.m.

Tuesday, May 27: Eighth grade students who qualified attend Six Flags. (Busses leave the school at 7:30 a.m. and return at approximately 9:00 p.m.)

Wednesday, June 4: Last day of school for 6th and 7th graders. The 6th grade awards assembly will take place at 8:40 a.m. and 7th grade at 10:45 a.m. in the Fine Arts Gym. Students who ordered yearbooks will get them at the end of the day. We will also have extras for sale for \$25.00. We'll dismiss early, at 11:30 a.m. Please note: This dismissal time is a correction from an earlier Parent Bulletin posting.
