**PARCC Testing:** Please be advised that WJHS students will be taking the computerized PARCC tests during three weeks in March. Test dates are class specific:

\*Eighth graders will test March 9,12,17,20,25

\*Seventh graders will test March 10,13,18, 23, 26

\*Sixth graders will test March 11,16, 19, 24, 27.
