Your coaches will be passing the packets out to you soon. If you lose it, we have extras in the office.

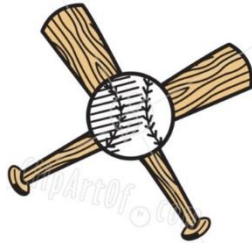
