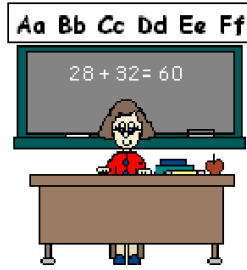
Girls Basketball: Tonight, the 6th-8th go to Lincoln with 6th grade starting at 5 bus leaves at 4pm.
