Guidance: WJHS classroom guidance lessons serve the academic, social, and emotional needs of our junior high students. Group guidance is a unique school experience that can help students express ideas and feelings, gain insight about themselves and others, and learn new behaviors to support academic goals. Mrs. Damery, the school counselor, will facilitate these prevention lessons and intervention activities during the school day. Topics include: note taking, organization, bullying/harassment, gossip and rumors, hazards of social media, and career exploration. The most recent guidance unit was delivered to the eighth grade class on September 28th covering social media. Seventh graders completed a note taking lesson on August 31st. Character Education will be covered at the fifth grade level on a monthly basis. All students will receive a bullying prevention lesson during the month of October.
