Miles of Smiles: The school district is excited to offer the mobile dentistry program Miles of Smiles to our student population again this fall. We hope this program will help alleviate some of the financial demand placed on families as they meet requirements for the beginning of the school year. All children, pre-kindergarten through 12th grade, are eligible for an exam. The services are provided at no cost to our district families. As an additional benefit to our families, the team fills out the dental forms for students in kindergarten, 2nd and 6th grade required by law to show proof of dental examination for school. Here is how the program works: Parents fill out the permission slip and return it to the school office. Exams will not be given unless the permission slip is returned to the school office. A team including a dentist, hygienists, and dental assistants will come to Sherman Elementary on Monday, November 4. Junior High students will be transported there for the clinic.
