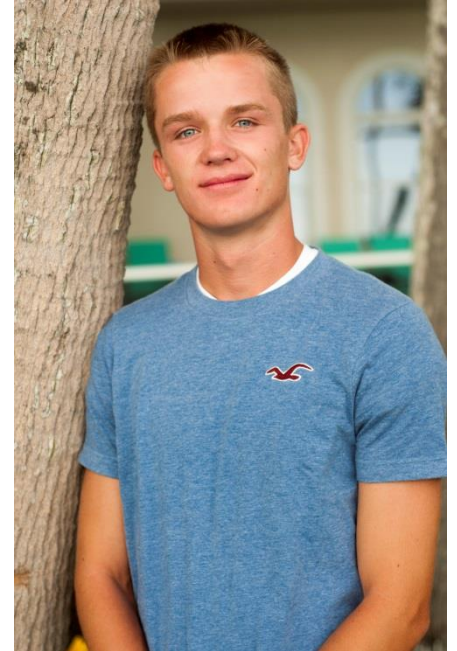


Andrew Roberts January Student of the Month
