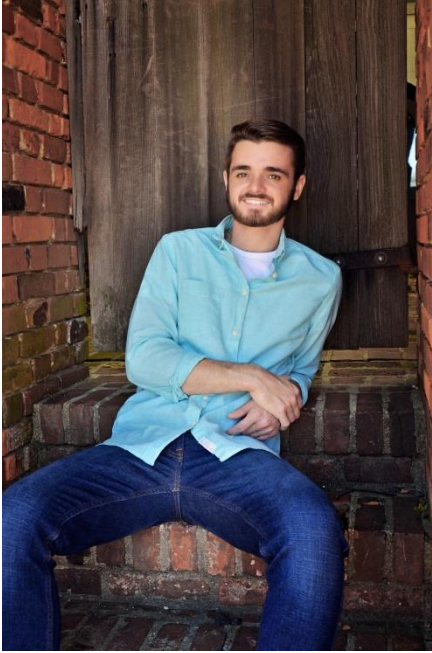


Zach Buscher
