7/8th grade: April 11-13

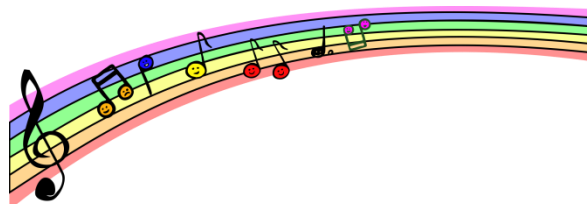
