The 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> Grade band students will perform at our 8<sup>th</sup> grade graduation on Friday night, May 25. Students need to dress nicely and be in the WJHS band room by 5:50 p.m. to warm up your instruments. They will provide processional and recessional music for the graduates at the 6:30 p.m. ceremony. Band students can be picked up at 8:00 p.m. in the front of the school after the ceremony.

### END OF THE YEAR DATES TO REMEMBER

**Wednesday, May 23:** Teachers and staff will have been reminding students about fees and fines owed for damaged or lost text and library books, p.e. rental fines, and negative lunch balances. These payments will need to be made in order for 8<sup>th</sup> graders to board the Six Flags bus and for the office staff to mail home report cards/graduation certificates once school ends for the summer.

**Thursday, May 24:** Eighth grade students who qualified will attend Six Flags. (Busses leave the school at 7:30 a.m. and return at approximately 9:00 p.m.) Students should dress appropriately, keeping school dress code guidelines in mind. Students should also be sure to bring money for food and drink.

**Friday, May 25: This is the last day of school for all students. School will dismiss at 11:30 a.m.**

Students will receive their yearbooks at the end of the day. If you didn't pre-order a yearbook in February but your student would like to purchase one, please send a check with them on that day made out to WJHS in the amount of \$25.00.

*\*8<sup>th</sup> graders will graduate at 6:30 p.m.\**

Once again this year, each person who attends the ceremony is required to have a ticket. A letter from Mr. Shoufler was mailed home on March 9 to each graduate. Included with the letter were 8 tickets for each student's family. This policy is to ensure that we stay within the Fire Marshall's guidelines for total capacity in the athletics gym. ### FIRST DAY SCHOOL SUPPLIES

\*Please note that the school supply kits are for your child's grade level supplies only. Extra supplies for Encore (Music, Art, PE) classes will need to be purchased separately. Kits will be delivered to the school and be available to pick up on the school's "locker day" on August 17.

### SCHOOL PHYSICALS

A complete physical is required on the first day of school for entrance into sixth and ninth grades (sports physicals are not acceptable). The State of Illinois health requirements for 6<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> grade students are listed on the district website at [wcusd15.org](http://wcusd15.org), choose District, and then choose Nurse. A letter was sent home with 5<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students. Parents may want to start scheduling these physicals now since appointments are sometimes difficult to get later in the summer. School physical forms are available at the physician's office, online or at the school office.

### DENTAL EXAMS

A dental exam is required for all 6<sup>th</sup> grade students. If you have appointments now for incoming 6<sup>th</sup> graders, please have the dentist office fill one out. If you have a current 6<sup>th</sup> grade student and have not sent in the form, you will receive a letter. Please help us fulfill our state requirement by bringing in the completed form.

The Williamsville High School Athletic Department will be hosting its mandatory parent/athlete night for all students who will be or are interested in participating in a sport for the upcoming Fall season. This includes football, volleyball, boys' soccer, boys' and girls' cross country, boys' and girls' golf, and cheerleading. The meeting will take place on Monday, May 21 starting at 6:00 pm in main gym at Williamsville High School. After the main session is finished in the gym, each sport will separate and conduct sport specific meetings. Important information for both open gyms this summer, as well as when tryouts and practices will take place this Fall will be covered at this time. It is highly recommended that you bring your health insurance card with you, as mandatory insurance waivers and IHSA paperwork will also be completed at this meeting; head coaches for each individual sport will also be collecting updated physicals if you have them. **Williamsville Junior High Boys Baseball Tryouts 2018**

Tryouts for JH Baseball will be held July 30 through August 1 at the baseball diamond located behind the high school. Boys entering 6th, 7th, and 8th grades are eligible to try out. Tryouts for 6th and 7th graders will begin at 8:00 a.m. and end at 9:45 a.m. Tryouts for 8th graders will begin at 10:00 a.m. and end at 11:45 p.m. Tryouts will be closed, so please drop your child off at the field and pick him up at the assigned time.

Remember, that if players do not have a current physical within the last year, they WILL NOT be able to participate in tryouts. Players will also need an insurance waiver (found on the district website) filled out by a parent and the \$80.00 athletic fee BEFORE they are able to tryout.

**Williamsville Junior High Girls Softball Tryouts 2018**

The tryouts for girls' softball will be July 23, 24, and 25, at the softball diamond located behind the football field. Girls entering 6th, 7th, and 8th grades are eligible to try out. Tryouts will begin at 4:00 p.m. and end at 5:30 p.m. each day. Those wishing to tryout as pitchers and catchers should plan to stay until 6:00 on Monday and Tuesday. Catchers should bring their equipment if they have it. Tryouts will be closed, so please drop your child off at the field and pick her up at the assigned time. We do this to keep all players focused on their coaches.

Remember, that if players do not have a current physical within the last year, they will not be able to participate in tryouts. Players will also need the completed insurance waiver form (found on the district website) on the first day of tryouts along with the \$80.00 athletic fee.

Please note: We will also have softball camp the same week. Camp will be in the morning on the same days from 8:30-10:30 a.m. All girls planning on attending tryouts should attend camp. Camp is \$50.00 and forms will be available at both SES and WJHS later in the spring.

**Williamsville Junior High Cross Country 2018**

There will be a parent meeting on Monday, July 30, at 6:30 p.m. at the track bleachers in Williamsville. The junior high cross country team will start practice on Tuesday, July 31, from 7:00 p.m. to around 8:15 p.m. We will meet in the bleachers at the school's track in Williamsville.

Everyone that comes out will participate. No one will be sitting on the bench at a meet. Runners should have a wrist stopwatch and a good pair of running shoes. If your shoes are new, walk around in them for a few days to break them in before the season starts.

\*No student will be allowed to try out without a current physical within the last year.

Players will also need the completed and signed Student-Parent Contract/Insurance Waiver form (found on the district website) on the first day of tryouts along with the \$80.00 athletic fee.

**\*\*\*Athletic Fee Information\*\*\***

**There is a cap of \$160 per student per year or \$160.00 per family per season. (Fall, Winter, and Spring)**

**Once an individual student has participated in two seasons and paid the \$80.00 fee for each season, they have met their individual "cap".**

**If a family has more than two students participating in an individual season, they would need to pay for two students (\$160.00) and the remaining student or students would be free.**
